



SENIOR PRIVILEGE PROGRAM 2017-2018

This program is designed for senior students to make responsible use of their non-instructional time. A Senior Pass (privilege) allows a senior student to leave campus, during unassigned periods, and freedom to go to various destinations within the building. However, it does not allow the student to be in an unauthorized area either inside or outside the school nor does it allow seniors to wander the building during these times.

- Senior Privileges will be granted to all Seniors for Quarter 1.
- To continue being eligible for Senior Privileges, a senior must be passing all subjects in each subsequent quarter, have the signed approval of a parent and have conducted themselves in a manner that is commensurate with these privileges.
- Senior students who cannot follow the Senior Privilege rules will have this privilege withdrawn and will be assigned to a quiet study hall during each non-instructional period.
- Senior privileges may be suspended as a result of unmet obligations.
- If a Senior loses his or her Senior Privilege, he or she may not leave campus until he or she has the approval of the administration. This period of time includes the student's lunch period.
- Once lost, for any reason, re-instatement will require an "Administrative Review" with their "Commons" administrator. The review will take into consideration Academic as well as disciplinary standing.
- Senior privileges can be revoked at any time upon parental/guardian request.

Exceptions to Privileges

Seniors with obligations from the previous years or who have not turned in their Student Information Form and Diploma Form are not eligible for privileges.
