



Student Contract for Summer Credit Recovery

Summer Credit Recovery Description:

Summer Credit Recovery is open to students who fail a semester or year-long course with a minimum grade of 50%. A plan is developed by the teacher and student that may include teacher generated materials and/or online lessons such as those provided by Odysseyware. On successful completion of the plan, the student recovers credit for the failed class but the failing grade remains on the transcript. The student who enrolls in summer credit recovery for athletic eligibility does not earn a grade greater than 60% for the recovered quarter.

Registration for 2018 Summer Credit Recovery is Wednesday, **June 20, 8:00am to 12:00pm** in the EHS Library. Credit Recovery Lab begins **June 25 and runs to July 13**, Monday through Friday 8:00am to 12:00 pm. The lab is closed July 4th. Teachers are on campus in the library to support student learning. Students have access from home but are **expected to report to EHS** during the duration of the program. All assessments are taken on campus. Industrious students may recover credit before July 13 and finish the program early.

Summer Credit Recovery Expectations:

- The student follows the Exeter High School behavior code (see Student Handbook) as well as rules specific to Summer Credit Recovery. Repeat violations of the rules will result in removal from the program.
- Computers are used only for completion of assigned coursework. No internet surfing or game playing.
- **The student signs-in and out of the lab and is expected to stay the duration of the period (8:00am-12:00pm)**
- All work must be done quietly. The students brings her own earbuds.
- The student must keep pace with the coursework to meet the expected completion date. If a student does not keep pace, he or she will be removed from the program and be required to retake the failed course in the fall.
- Discipline concerns may result in restarting the course from the beginning or removal from the lab or program.
- **No tests can be taken at home.** Any test taken at home will be considered invalid and must be repeated.
- A passing score is set at or above 70%.
